Our Ready to WIN program will work with juvenile offenders in an effort to ensure that they are poised for success and Ready to WIN at life.

The Ready to WIN initiative is a 6-8 week alternative (to jail, out of school suspension, and long term probation) program for adjudicated youth ages 13–22 that provides them alternatives to tough situations. Upon successful completion, participants will have an opportunity to enroll in our WIN program and connect to their future.
